HONOR FLIGHT

On Sunday, April 12th, Schooner sponsored a screening of the documentary *Honor Flight* at the Franco American Heritage Center as part of the Emerge Film Festival. The documentary is about the non-profit group of the same name which flies World War II Veterans, free of charge, to the World War II memorial which opened in 2004.



This special film festival event featured a salute to our armed forces, a screening of a short introductory film about why Schooner Estates decided to be a sponsor, and a question and answer panel after the movie. Schooner's film featured our own residents saying the pledge of allegiance as well as snippets from interviews with several of our community's World War II veterans, and staff commentary. Schooner was represented at the question and answer panel by our very own Irving Grant, who was one of two Schooner residents to attend Honor Flight Maine's Inaugural flight last year. Irving was joined on stage by Honor Flight's founder, Earl Morse, and the documentary's director, Dan Hayes.
