Even though her parents came to America at a very young age, they were raised bilingual, and, at her grandfather's insistence, so were Tek and her siblings.

Tek's love of learning translated into a life full of adventure, where she could see all of what the world had to offer. After graduating from Luther L. Wright High School in Ironwood, Michigan, she then studied nursing in Chicago. With her education finished, Tek considered joining the Army, and was eventually convinced to do it when her sister said "You wouldn't dare!" Tek served in the Korean War, and was stationed in a tent hospital in Korea for nearly a year.

Here at Schooner, Tek continues to make the most of every day by participating in many activities, especially the educational opportunities that Schooner provides. We're glad to have this opportunity to learn a little more about her and her fascinating life!
