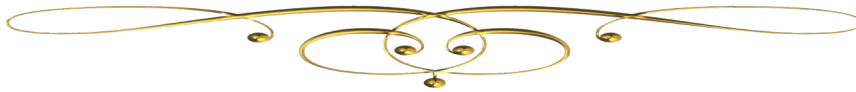
## Schooner Tenant Profiles
